How to...

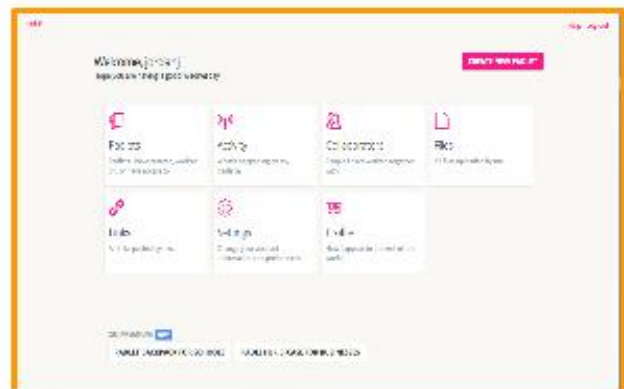
possibly the easiest way to create and collaborate in the world
